The scenes with Baanraak and Lauren have been uniformly slower, harder to write, and with smaller final word counts — and when I'm done with them, I am by-God done. Reading over the material, I like what I have in both sections equally well. But if this pattern continues, I may have to refigure my schedule. I built in a lot of padding for the due date, but padding is one of those things you really don't want to use if you can avoid it.

Here's hoping my time with the other three goes smoothly tomorrow — and here's hoping that something clicks for me with Baanraak and Molly and they become easier to work with.
